Tony Jarrett



Tony Jarrett is a former Olympic hurdler who won many medals over his twenty-year career, including the 4x100 relay silver medal with fellow athletes Linford Christie, John Regis, and Colin Jackson and a Gold medal at the 1998 Commonwealth Games in Kuala Lumpur. He came 4th in the 110m hurdles at the 1992 summer Olympics in Barcelona, narrowly missing out on a bronze medal by 1000th of a second to Jack Pierce of the USA. He is now a coach, working with other accomplished sports professionals in sprint and endurance conditioning. He also mentors young students on a one-to-one basis which includes motivating them to reach their full potential.

Courtney Fry



Courtney Fry is a British former boxer who competed professionally from 2003 to 2015. As an amateur, he won a gold medal at the 1998 Commonwealth Games and represented Great Britain at the 2000 Sydney Olympics. As a professional, he challenged once for the British, and Commonwealth light-heavyweight titles in 2009.

Sasha Corbin



Sasha Corbin is an English international netball player, who made her debut with the England national team in 2007, and competed at the 2014 Commonwealth Games, where England lost the bronze medal match to Jamaica to finish fourth. At club level she plays for the Hertfordshire Mavericks and has previously played for Team Bath, Loughborough Lightning and Northern Mystics.
